



PGA Tournament Series



History

The PGA Tournament Series debuted during the 1977-78 winter season to provide additional playing opportunities for PGA Professionals. It rapidly developed into one of the Association's most popular member events. The tournaments are open to PGA members and apprentices currently registered and in good standing in the PGA Professional Golf Management Program (PGM). The 2010 season was the 24th in a row with the full schedule of events contested in South Florida. It attracted 324 PGA Professional entries representing 25 states, while offering a combined purse of \$80,999.98.

In 1996, the Series became the first PGA-sanctioned event to be held at PGA Golf Club in Port St. Lucie, Fla., The PGA of America's first owned-and-operated public golf facility. PGA Golf Club hosted two Regular and two Senior Division events, and nearby PGA Country Club hosted one event in both divisions. The 2010 PGA Tournament Series schedule featured six events that combined players senior (over-50) and younger, with four events at PGA Golf Club and two at nearby PGA Country Club in Port St. Lucie, Fla.
