PALM BEACH GARDENS, Fla. – For the 17th consecutive year, the PGA Minority Collegiate Golf Championship presented by Brown Capital Management will include a Business of Golf Career Expo, featuring golf industry associations and companies that enable student-athletes to learn about additional employment opportunities in manufacturing, media, trade, golf course management and the game’s premier governing bodies. Student-athletes will have the opportunity to present resumes for internships and employment.

“We are very excited to offer the Business of Golf Career Expo to student-athletes competing in the PGA Minority Collegiate Golf Championship presented by Brown Capital Management,” said PGA of America President Allen Wronowski. “This event allows participants to interact and learn more about many of top organizations and companies in the golf industry.”

Since the Business of Golf Career Expo’s inception, 24 former student-athletes have gone on to become PGA members. Six of those PGA members are now college golf coaches.
