PGA OF AMERICA SCHOLARSHIPS

The PGA of America and the PGA Foundation provide scholarships for educational pursuits to children and grandchildren of PGA members, along with students in the PGA Golf Management University Programs. Over the past three decades, The PGA of America has helped approximately 3,463 students, while contributing more than \$6.5 million in scholarships. The following are the current scholarship programs:

CHIP BECK/PGA EVANS SCHOLARSHIP

The Chip Beck/PGA Evans Scholarship was established in 1994, three years after Beck became the second player in history to record a 59 in a PGA Tour-sanctioned event. The Evans Scholarship Program, founded in 1930, honors golf great Chick Evans. The program, which was begun for caddies who seek a college education, has provided college scholarships to more than 10,000 students nationwide. Each year the Chip Beck/PGA Evans scholar is awarded \$12,500, and 18 scholars have received a total of \$225,000 since the scholarship was established. The 2011-12 recipient is:

PGA FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FUND SCHOLARSHIPS

The PGA Financial Assistance Fund Scholarship Program, founded in 1986, encourages and promotes the attainment of higher education goals for children and grandchildren of PGA of America members. The applicants have demonstrated a high level of academic achievement during high school and/or college. In 2011, the program awarded 134 scholarships totaling \$292,000, to high school graduating seniors and college students nationally. Total applicants equaled 701 scholarship applications. Since its inception, the PGA Financial Assistance Fund Scholarship Program has provided more than \$4.8 million to 2,392 students.
